Narrative Summary:

Tennessee built a commanding lead only to be surpassed by Union University and the schools exchanged the lead a few times before the Final Jeopardy (FJ) question. Coastal Carolina was a close third halfway through the contest. Into the FJ question, Union was up by 2000 points over Tennessee and those two schools and Coastal Carolina were the only schools with positive scores in that phase of the contest. Amazingly, all three schools answered the JF correctly and with a strategic wager, Union captured first place with Tennesseee in second place (by only 200 points) followed by Coastal Carolina and Kennesaw in third and fourth places, respectively.
